President's Message

The Hawks start the new season full of optimism with new faces joining the Club alongside our many loyal Club stalwarts. On the playing side, we have entered 15 teams under the FFSA, with the addition of a new Under 17s girls team. Hawks Nest - a progress report

In November last year the Hawks main pitch underwent a makeover to include the installation of pitch drainage and automated pop-up sprinklers. This involved trenching over 20 rows and laying down the drainage and sprinkler systems, backfilling, reseeding and fertilising - a mammoth project!

This job was kick-started by the President, who took a week of his holidays to complete the trenching. Four subsequent working bees over a two-week period broke the back of the job.

In addition to the main pitch work, the Club has completed significant earth moving to build a new Junior pitch, which has now been top-dressed and seeded. We hope this will be ready some time this season. A new training area is now being constructed and the Club has plans to install some pitch lighting in 2011. The Club wishes to thank Ben Pritchard Forklifts for providing the Kanga digger. This was an enormous help and saved us considerable expense, making the total project viable within the Club's budget.
