This Newsletter is primarily to announce the Club's plans to build a Clubhouse at the Hawks Nest and to seek the support of all our members and supporters in this exciting endeavour. It is unlikely that we will be able to secure financial support by way of grant funding from the Adelaide Hills Council in the near term.

However, with more matches being played at the Hawks Nest it is clear there is a need to have some shelter for parents and supporters and for a modest indoor food and beverage

facility. So, as the Club did with the changing rooms back in 1993, our best option is to build it ourselves!

Accordingly, the Committee is announcing a specific Clubhouse Fundraising Campaign to raise sufficient funds for building materials and essential fit out. More details of the plans are outlined below. Please spread the word on this major initiative for the Club and become involved in making it happen.

The last Newsletter showed a picture of Hawks volunteers constructing what is the current Hawks changing room and toilet facilities. The work of these early Hawks pioneers has inspired the Committee to start a process which will lead to the construction of a Clubhouse.

A working group has been established which includes Sam Aukland, Adam Nicholson and Simon Wegener, who together produced a first draft of a Clubhouse which has been presented to the Committee for initial feedback. Sam has subsequently produced some 3D models and has begun discussions with Council in order to obtain necessary approvals.



So if you have skills and a willingness to contribute, please make yourself known to a Committee Member. Similarly, if you know of building materials suppliers who may be willing to donate or offer significant discounts, please let us know.

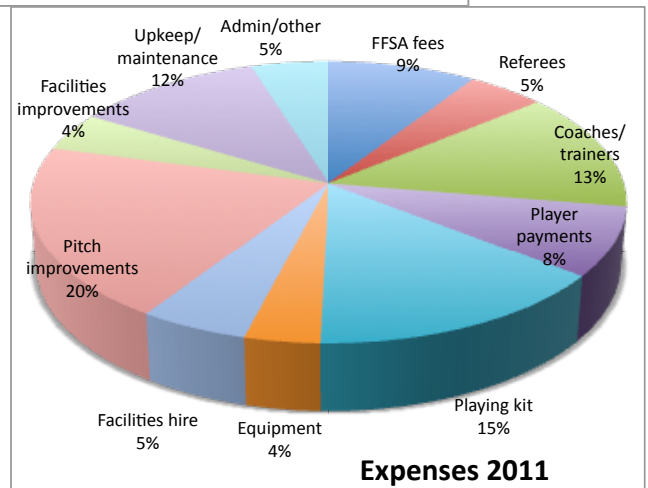
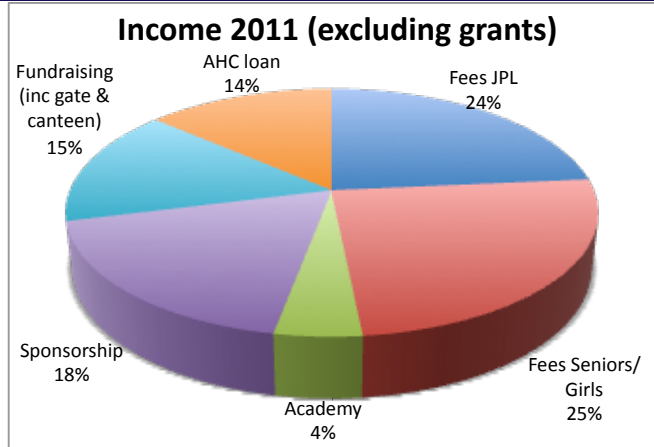
Funding the project

These charts give you some idea of how your money is allocated in keeping our players on the pitch and the Club functioning. (N.B. These are “budget” estimates - “actuals” may vary.)

In our current financial circumstances, it will be many years before we can see any possibility of a new clubhouse.

Accordingly, the Club is launching a major fundraising effort, with the view to making a start on the building, and possibly completing it, within a two year time frame.

Once our fundraising efforts are underway, we hope to be better placed to apply for State government grants, which will then realise our clubhouse goal in a shorter time frame.



Clubhouse4Hawks fundraising campaign - target \$50K

A specific fundraising campaign is being launched to try to raise \$50K towards the cost of the Clubhouse. In order to keep this separate from the Club’s ongoing operating expenses which are primarily financed from players’ subscriptions, sponsorship and gate and canteen receipts, a separate account has been established with Bank SA.

All funds raised specifically for the Clubhouse will go into this account to be used solely for the Clubhouse Project.

The first activity in this fundraising campaign is a “**mega raffle**” (well, for the Hawks at least). There are over 30 wonderful prizes, details of which are on the following page.

A second thrust to our fundraising campaign is to encourage tax deductible donations to the **Australian Sports Foundation**.

The Australian Sports Foundation assists non-profit sporting organizations such as the Hawks to raise money for sport-related projects such as building a new clubroom.

Other specific fundraising activities have been discussed. These are a quiz night in Adelaide to coincide with the Masters Tournament in October and a sponsored bike ride on the weekend before the Tour Down Under in January.

Your feedback on these ideas, as well as any other ideas you have, is welcome.

Who sells the tickets?
